**Outstanding Woman of the Year**

Each year the President's Commission on Women's Issues honors an outstanding woman on our campus for her exemplary contributions to women and women's issues in higher education.

**The following guidelines delineate what nominees are expected to have accomplished to be considered for this honor.**

1. Employed at the University of Maryland for at least five years.
2. Must have demonstrated service to women and women's issues in higher education.
3. A record of outstanding performance in all aspects of her professional role.

**Additionally, accomplishments in the following areas will be considered:**

- National recognition for research or scholarly achievement with regard to women's issues.
- National recognition for or leadership in professional societies, organizations or athletics.
- Excellence in teaching, advising, and/or mentoring that demonstrates a concern for and commitment to women.
- Outstanding service to the University of Maryland community, campus administrative achievement or service to the broader community.
